(**Royal Netherlands Yacht Club**)

18 – 19 May 2019

Location: IJsselmeer near Muiden

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS, 2017-2020)*.
- 1.2 The sailing instructions may change racing rules
- 1.3 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Regenbogen Class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on the website of the class organisation and pay the entry fee of € 50,-.
- 3.3 Eligible competitors shall meet all ownership, class membership and boat measurement requirements as laid down in the class rules and must have paid the entry fee before becoming official competitors.
- 3.4 No entries will be accepted after 13 May 2019, 12.00 hrs.

4 FEES

Required fees are € 50,- per yacht and have to be paid to the IBAN number on the entry form before becoming official competitor. Entrants are bound to pay the entry fee.

The entry fee includes craning in and out of the water, mooring during the weekend, "beer" after the races and a free of charge diner for 3 crewmembers, including wine and coffee, on Saturday 18th of May

5 SPARE

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 Registration takes place at the Regatta Office on 18th of May 2019 from 09.00 – 10.30 hrs.

6.2 Dates of racing, number of races:

- Saturday 18 May 2019: 3 races
- Sunday 19 May 2019: 3 races

6.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be on:

- Saturday 12:10 hrs
- Sunday 11:10 hrs.

On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:10 hrs.

6.4 The number of races per day will be decided by the race committee, based upon the time spent on the water, the wind conditions as expected and arisen, and the expected time of arrival in the marina.

6.5 The Regenbogen Class Event will be sailed together with the International Dragon Regatta in Muiden. Each Class will be started as a separate starting group.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and a valid insurance certificate (NoR 20) upon registration. In addition, boats and crews may be inspected at the discretion of the Race Committee.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available from 09:00 hrs – 10:30 hrs on 18th of May at the Regatta Office, located in the hall of the KNZ&RV clubhouse and will also be available latest 13th of May on the website www.knzrv.nl.

9 VENUE

The venue is the KNZ&RV, Royal Netherlands Yacht Club, Westzeedijk 7, 1398 BB Muiden, The Netherlands, Telephone +31-294261540.
The racing areas will be approximately 1-3 Nm of the harbour on the Markermeer.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be of the upwind-downwind type, with upwind spreader buoy and downwind mark or gate. Courses will be laid with a leg length of 0.8 – 1.5 nm, if possible.

11 SPARE

12 SCORING

12.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5 to 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 SPARE

14 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour.

Yachts may be craned in and out of the water at the facilities of the KNZ&RV after contacting the harbourmasters.

15 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Yachts shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

16 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

17 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

18 PRIZES

- Less than 9 entries 2 prizes
- 9 to 18 entries 3 prizes
- 19 to 29 entries 4 prizes
- Above 29 entries 5 prizes

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

20 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsor the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of € 1.500.000 per event or the equivalent.

Route A1 from East and West:

Exit "Muiden Weesp" and follow route to Muiden, enter Muiden on the "Weesperweg"

At the end of "Weesperweg" at the roundabout turn right and cross the bridge.

Directly after the bridge turn left into the "Burg.Raadtsingel".

Keep pond at left side until end of pond, turn right into the "Julianalaan"

At the end cross the dike into the KNZ&RV premisses.
